Prepare For Next Sunday’s Readings

Next Sunday, Jesus taught that he was the vine and that his disciples were the branches. We hear Jesus affirm that he is known by the Father and that his disciples will know the Father by knowing Jesus. Those who know Jesus well—and Jesus says that his disciples do know him—will love one another. Knowledge leads to love, which leads to action. Jesus taught that love is the sign of a true disciple and, thus, a true Christian. Even more, a true disciple shows a particular kind of love, sacrificial love. Jesus teaches that his relationship to his disciples is based on friendship, not servitude. The disciples of Jesus were chosen and were sent into the world to bear fruit by serving others, by sacrificing for others, in love. We know that Jesus himself gives us the greatest example of the kind of love and service that he teaches to his disciples. He has, in fact, laid down his life for his friends, for his disciples, and for us. Through his death and Resurrection, we have received the grace to love others as Jesus has commanded.

A Pilgrim's Progress

On Wednesday April 17th folks from Coles County and around the Mattoon Deanery joined thousands of Illinoisans of all ages, including many high school and college students, at the Illinois March for Life in Springfield. 1500 Catholics preceded the March by attending a concelebrated mass with Bishop Paprocki on the campus of the U of I – Springfield.

March participants heard speakers describe how Illinois has become an abortion magnet for the Midwest including three new abortion clinics in Carbondale alone. They are being promoted as being good for the local economy. One physician shared how she was conceived as a child of both rape and incest. Yet her mother was enabled to choose life and spared the additional trauma of abortion. Today she knows herself to be a beloved child of God whose life was not ended by the often mentioned “exceptions” to not having an abortion.

Other speakers addressed how legislation promoting the direct taking of innocent human life via “assisted suicide” is currently working its way through the Illinois legislature. More information is available at illinoisrighttolife.org This is particularly a threat to the lives of the disabled.

It is no surprise a culture struggling with valuing those living in the dawn of life struggles with valuing our neighbors in the dusk and shadows of life. We do not become a more humane society by eliminating those people who are sick, disabled, dying, or lack good insurance. The act of taking one's life is always a tragedy, no matter the circumstances. There is no reason to minimize the serious nature of terminal illness and how it effects patients and their families. It is also not necessary to encourage suicide as a form of escape. As Pope Francis has challenged us, “we must accompany people towards death, but not provoke death or facilitate assisted suicide.” Accompanying those we love through life's final stages, however difficult they are, is an essential part of life, and part of what it means to be family.

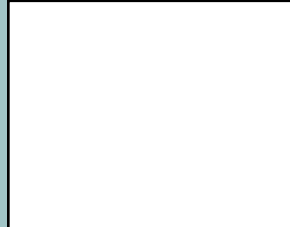
