



DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



"Eight days later Jesus came and stood in their midst."

John 20:19-31

Prepare For Next Sunday's Readings

Next Sunday, we continue to hear Gospel accounts of Jesus' appearances to his disciples following his Resurrection. This reading follows immediately after the report of Jesus' appearance to his disciples on the road to Emmaus. Jesus greets his disciples with the words, "Peace be with you." Even as they hear Jesus' greeting of peace, the disciples are startled and terrified. They are uncertain about what to make of the figure before them and, quite understandably, they mistake Jesus for a ghost. Yet the figure before them is not a ghost; Jesus invites them to experience his resurrected body with their senses, to look and to touch. The figure before them is flesh and bone, still bearing the marks of crucifixion. Although the disciples cannot forget his suffering and death, peace begins to take root in their hearts, as their fears turn to joy and amazement. As further proof of his identity and of his resurrected body, Jesus eats with his disciples. The disciples have known Jesus best through the meals that he has shared with them. As Jesus commissions his disciples to be witnesses to what Scriptures foretold, our celebration of the Eucharist commissions us. Like the disciples, we are sent to announce the good news of Jesus' forgiveness of sins.

A Pilgrim's Progress

In the 1930s St. Faustina Kowalska, a nun in Poland, received visits from Jesus and had discussions with him. The Lord came to her in a white garment with red and blue rays streaming from his heart. Christ asked her to have his image made into a painting with the words "Jesus I trust in You" for the veneration of the faithful. Christ asked her for the Feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the 2nd Sunday, the octave day, of Easter.

Pope St. John Paul II canonized St. Faustina as the first new saint of the 3rd Christian millennium and established the feast in the Jubilee Year 2000. At the request of her spiritual director St. Faustina wrote a lengthy diary chronicling her conversations with the Lord. The message of Divine Mercy has been described as as simple as ABC. Ask for Christ's mercy. Be merciful. Completely Trust in Jesus Christ.

There will be a Divine Mercy Holy Hour at IC today, Divine Mercy Sunday, from 2:30 to 3:30. It will include Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, praying of the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00 P.M. the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Benediction. All are welcome.






