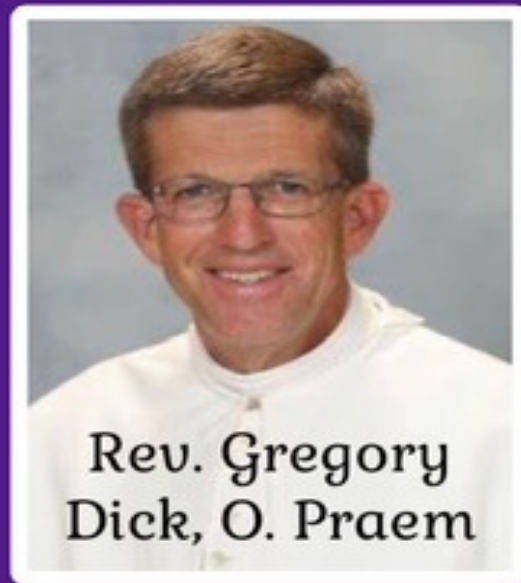
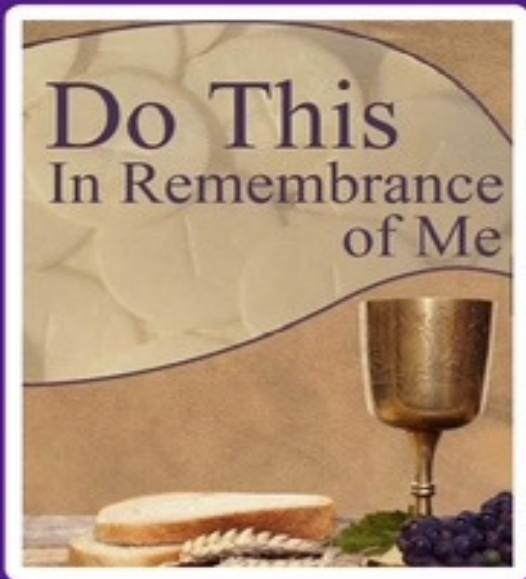

Prepare For Next Sunday’s Readings

For the Third Sunday of Lent, the dialogue between Jesus and a woman from Samaria is among the most lengthy and most theological found in Scripture. The most startling aspect of the conversation is that it happens at all. The woman herself alludes to the break from tradition: “How can you, a Jew, ask me, a Samaritan woman, for a drink?” Yet Jesus not only converses with the woman, he also asks to share her drinking vessel, an action that makes him unclean according to Jewish law. The high point of the conversation is when Jesus reveals himself to her as the Messiah. After the conversation, the Samaritan woman becomes a disciple. Even though she is an outcast and not a Jew, she returns to her town to lead others to Jesus. The significance of the encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman has many levels. The first is personal: The woman is herself converted to belief in Jesus as Messiah because he knows her sin but speaks with her just the same. The second is social: Having come to know Jesus as the Messiah, the Samaritan woman becomes an evangelist to her own people. The third level of the story is educational: Jesus uses his encounter with the Samaritan woman to teach his disciples that God’s mercy is without limit.

A Pilgrim's Progress

Last Tuesday we learned of the death of Fr. Jim Neuman, a retired priest of our diocese. Fr Jim was ordained in 1971 and came to Immaculate Conception as his first assignment. He served as parochial vicar to Msgr. William Croke until 1975.

There are fond memories of his time here. Many recall the parish masses, baptisms, marriages, and funerals he celebrated. Fr. Jim made lasting friendships with many of our parishioners.

While I was not raised a Catholic, but growing up in Mattoon, I first met Fr. Jim when one evening he knocked on the front door of our home on Western Avenue. My mom was having a party that evening and Fr. Jim recognized the cars of many IC parishioners on our block. He wanted to know why he had not been invited as well. That oversight was never repeated.

A year later Fr. Jim was at a gathering at our home shortly before my high school graduation. He said he would be praying that I made good vocational choices in the years to come. He must have prayed hard. Ten years later (by then I was a Catholic) I was applying to the seminary.

Father's funeral mass will be this Tuesday at St. Agnes Church in Hillsboro where he served many years as pastor.

Please continue to keep him and all our faithful departed in your prayers.
